HOUSE OF BREAD

Woodseaves Primary Academy are supporting the local charity House of Bread (HoB) again this year. House of Bread do a fantastic job by supporting homeless people in Stafford but they have seen an increase in demand of people needing help. The HoB Food Bank supplies roughly 500 tins of food to vulnerable, low income families and individuals in and around Stafford each and every week. They need donations of: soup, meals in a tin, tinned fruit, tinned vegetables, tinned fish, pasta, rice and baked beans.

This year HoB have also launched “Quid on a Lid”. They would like a one pound coin to be stuck on one of the donated food items. This will help support the increasing range of services that House of Bread provide for vulnerable people.

A representative from HoB will be coming into school on Wednesday 11th October to collect the donated items and also see our children.

If you would like to donate items and contribute to “Quid on a Lid” then please drop all items into school from Monday **9th October** to **Wednesday 11th October**.
