## **Impact**

### **Inspection Data Dashboard Summary**

- Disadvantaged KS2 pupils had an average point score equal to or above the national score for other pupils in reading and maths
- The proportion of disadvantaged KS2 pupils that attained level 4 was equal to or above the national figure for other pupils in reading, writing and maths
- KS2 value added in all subjects was broadly average or above for disadvantaged pupils.
- All disadvantaged pupils in Year 1 passed the Phonics check
