

2016-2017 Equality Objectives

Each year the school will set specific equality targets to improve the provision set out within this policy.

School equality objectives for 2016-2017 are:

1. To further improve accessibility for pupils with dyslexia by reviewing the school's Dyslexia Friendly status and applying for reaccreditation through a revised action plan. This will be coordinated by our SENCO Mrs Jeffries in liaison with staff.
2. To review the SEN-D Policy and SEND offer for the school in light of a WSMAT joint SENCO being appointed across the 3 schools.
3. To review the Accessibility Plan for the school and implement any changes arising.

These Equality Objectives will be reviewed annually and the findings published on the website.

Review of Equality Objectives June 2016-17

1. The school has started an audit of provision and the action plan is being drawn up so this objective will continue into the next academic year.
2. The SEN-D policy and Local Offer have been revised and updated.
3. The school is able to provide for current needs within the school but this will remain under review subject to new intakes of pupils. The school has made appropriate arrangements for the provision of a pupil with medical needs arriving in Reception. Appropriate agencies have been consulted, staff training has been delivered and good communication systems put in place.
