Investigating a contrasting locality

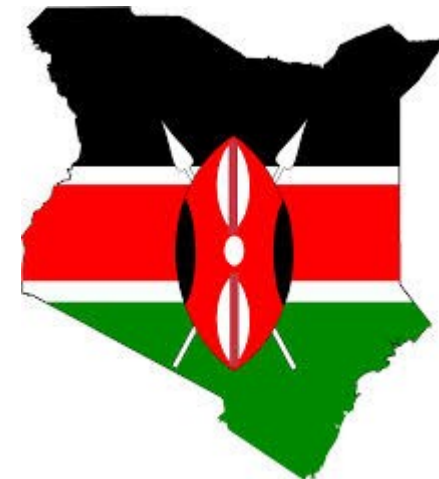
We will be learning about life in Kenya, it's wild-life and physical geography.
